General information about ARNA

The artist in residence of ARNA started 2011 by local artists and an active community as an EU-project, aiming to develop the Avian Kingdom as a venue for art and nature. The Avian Kingdom is situated in the most southern part of Sweden with several protected territories of international standards. For the future there is a vision for the area to become part of a new UNESCO biosphere area.

As part of the Avian Kingdom ARNA is building up an international residency in the village of Harlösa. The residency welcomes artists and scientists to make their personal interpretation of humans relationship to nature during their stay. Artist in residence is also about finding inspiration, in ARNA's case while meeting the Scandinavian nature, culture and people.

Housing

ARNA rent housing for the residents in the village of Harlösa for one season at a time.

During 2014

we will rent the old farmhouse/cottage as seen below, suitable for two persons sharing kitchen and studio/livingroom. The bedroom upstairs has a double bed and the bedroom downstairs has a single bed. The house has two bathrooms. It is a friendly and fun house, actually the oldest in the village of Harlösa. One resident will be welcomed to share house and studio with one of our artists in Harlösa, living in a big house with a very nice studio in a separate building.

The village of Harlösa

Harlösa is a small village with 850 inhabitants. In the village is a grocery, public library and pizza restaurant. Buses to nearest town (Lund, distance 25 km) departs 10 times a days during weekdays and 5 times a day during weekends. Bikes can be borrowed for daytrips out in the surroundings. For longer trips there is a car to rent.

How to go to ARNA

It is easy to reach ARNA by bus and train from Kastrup international airport in Copenhagen. The whole trip will take 1,5 hours. We recommend our residents to get flights to Copenhagen that arrives to Kastrup between 7.30 in the morning to the latest 7.30 in the evening. If so, we meet with a car in Lund and drive you to ARNA with all your luggage.
